What is a scaled score?

Tests are developed to the same specification each year. However, because the questions must be different, the difficulty of tests may vary. This means we need to convert the total number of marks a pupil gets in a test (their 'raw' score) into a scaled score, to ensure we can make accurate comparisons of performance over time.

Pupils scoring at least 100 will have met the expected standard on the test. However, given that the difficulty of the tests may vary each year, the number of raw score marks needed to achieve a scaled score of 100 may also change. For example, if the overall difficulty of a test decreases compared to previous years, the raw score required to meet the expected standard will increase. Similarly, if the test is more difficult, the raw score required to meet the expected standard will decrease.

¹ Pupils are meeting the expected standard if they achieve a scaled score of 100 or more in their reading and maths tests.

² Pupils are achieving at a higher standard if they achieve a scaled score of 110 or more in their reading and maths tests. This standard was set for the first time in 2016 to provide information about pupils across England achieving in the top 5%.

³ This score shows how well pupils performed in the key stage 2 reading test. This score is known as the reading 'scaled score'. The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

⁴ This score shows how well pupils performed in the key stage 2 maths test. This score is known as the maths 'scaled score'. The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

⁵ This score shows how well pupils performed in the key stage 2 SPaG test. This score is known as the SPaG 'scaled score'. The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

⁶ The mean scores for Reading, Maths and SPaG are aggregated.
